## DIRECTOR'S CUT



Northwestern Baptist Association has a long history of mission work, dating back more years than I can document, and meeting needs literally across the US and Mexico. Our people have been traveling for years teaching VBS, assisting in church building projects, helping new church plants and serving the Lord in a variety of ministry opportunities. In recent years the number of people who have served in the annual association mission trip has swelled to near 100!

This year, our Missions Committee believes that our effort should be focused here at home. This is not a disaster relief need, or a church building project, nor is it a VBS. We have a great need at the NWBA Campground and are calling on the people of NWBA to get involved. You may remember that the Paruna Baptist Church donated its building to the association and funded the cost to move the building to its new home at the Campground. In order to use the building we need to do a 're-fit.' Our goal is to put on a new roof, build in a bathroom and remodel the cabin sleeping area. We will also work on new siding and front steps. None of this work is outside of the expertise or our people! We can do this, but it will require your help and support.

We have elected to start this work during Spring Break this March. We are asking each church to take on a project or two, or partner with another church to fill out a project that needs to be completed. In addition to construction there are many needs at the camp that can be accomplished with a large group of people in a very short amount of time. Many of the buildings could use fresh paint, the trails will need to be cleared for summer use and we need to put a new roof on the shop.

Will you help? Our Missions and Properties committees are working hard to organize this effort so that our labor will be efficient. We hope to kick off the Spring Break Mission with a great workday on Saturday the 13<sup>th</sup> followed by an optional afternoon of work on the 14<sup>th</sup> and worship time together that evening.

This is a great opportunity to advance the ministries of our churches through camp gatherings. The additional bed space will enable us to meet more needs and accommodate more people than we ever have before! We hope to provide a great place where the Gospel can be proclaimed and people can grow in their relationship with the Lord at the NWBA Campground.

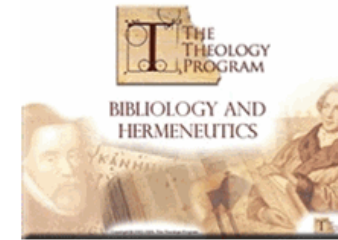
