It is a great day in Northwestern Baptist Association. I am so thankful for the response that we have had to "Mission Campground". We have people from over 9 churches and the BSU in Alva committed to come to our grounds over Spring Break and work hard for the Glory of God. We have made a fairly significant change to our plans for the grounds that I want to share with you.

Since we began the process of receiving and moving the Paruna Baptist Church building to the grounds I have envisioned it as a converted cabin. Though this helped us in the area of bed space, it did not help us in so many other areas, and required a pretty substantial remodel to the structure. A new plan was offered by two men from FBC Mooreland that will serve the whole camp experience **and** will increase the number of beds. The Properties Committee has voted to convert the kitchen and small meeting space in the Overton Center to be a second dorm. They also agree that we should leave the large meeting space in the Paruna building intact, to give us a better space for missions training and other presentations/teachings. The kitchen and fellowship area will return to a kitchen and will serve as our new snack and refreshment area for camp. The committee also voted to add three showers and a handicap bathroom to the front of the Paruna building, allowing it to be used for overflow bed space if there is a need.

I am very excited about this plan. It seems as if the Lord has worked in the hearts of His people to bring unity and clear direction. I hope that you will come down to the Campground on Sunday, March 14 at 6:00 pm for our joint worship service. Please pray for those working over the week of Spring Break and pray that God will use our efforts to accomplish much in the Kingdom of Christ.

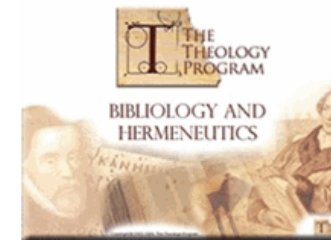
