The Minutes of the Regular Ex. Board Meeting on August 30, 2010 was approved as presented.

Financial Reports were approved.

Committee Reports

Personnel: There will be no raises across the board for the staff in 2011. There will be adjustments to insurance and annuity on John Elam and Todd White and RaNita King will receive a bonus of 2 x weekly salary to be recognized at the Annual Meeting on October 24, 2010. Carried.

Budget for 2011 was discussed and moved to be accepted as presented. Carried. Budget will be publicized in the Annual Meeting book.

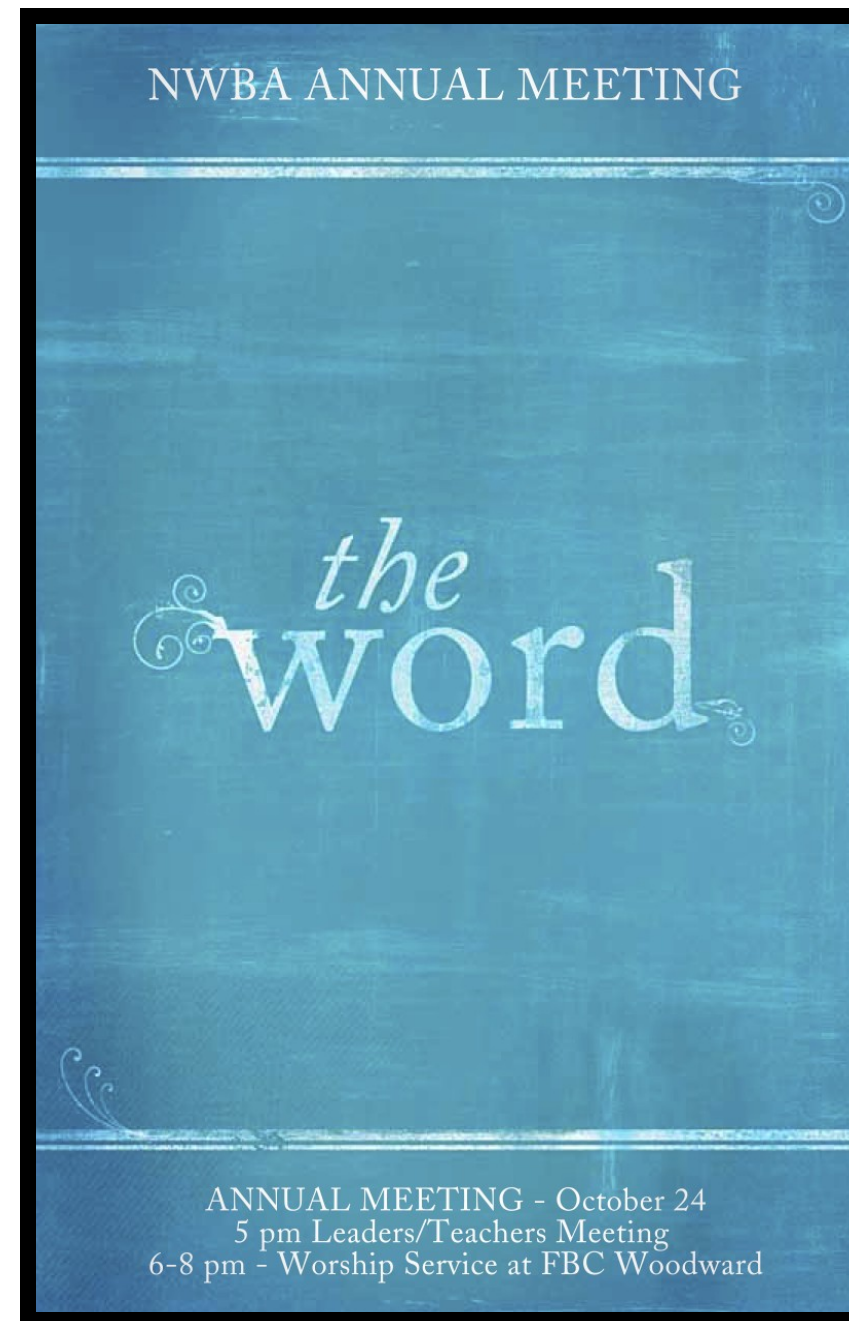

NEWS FROM CAMP

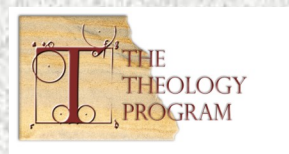
