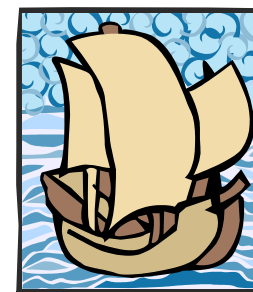


How to Pack a Shoe Box Gift

- SHOE BOX:** Use an empty shoe box (standard size, please) or a small plastic container. You can wrap the box (lid separately), but wrapping is not required. **PRAY** for the child who will receive your special gift.
- BOY OR GIRL:** Determine whether your gift will be for a boy or a girl, and the child's age category; 2-4, 5-9, or 10-14. Use the appropriate boy/girl label and mark the correct age, and tape the label to the top of your box.
- FILL WITH GIFTS:** Fill the box with a variety of gifts that will bring delight to a child. There is a gift list available.
- INCLUDE YOUR DONATION:** Place your donation of \$7 or more for each shoe box to help with the shipping and other project cost.
- DROP OFF:** Place a rubber band around each shoe box and lid and drop off at the Collection Center nearest you in Mid-November. Drop Off locations located inside newsletter.
